Vacations-

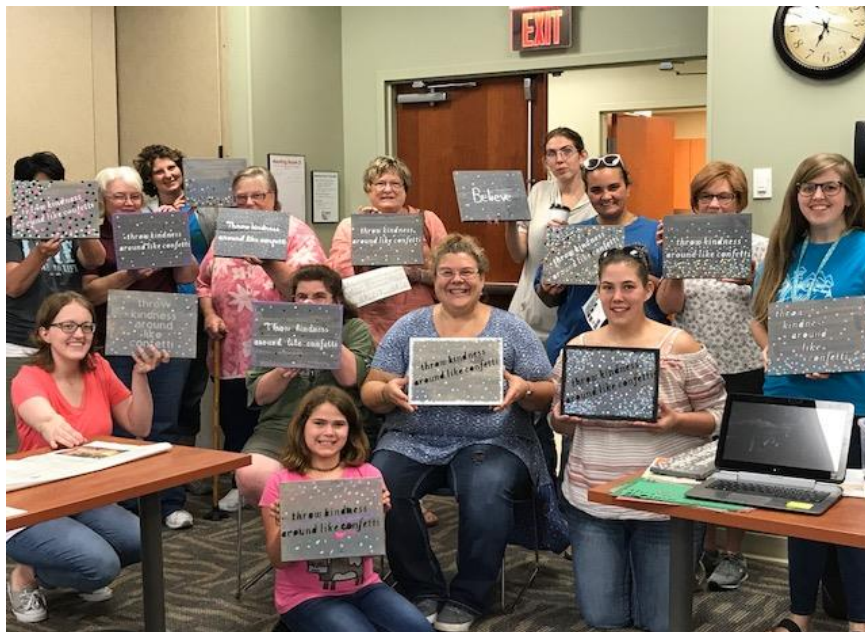
We scheduled a few less programs this month so that staff could use some vacation time. We are so happy summer is over because our programs are filling up again.
