# Getting started with Nook Tablets

All you need to get started is your:

- device
- an internet connection
- library's name
- personal library card number

You can use the OverDrive app to get eBooks, audiobooks, streaming videos, and periodicals from your library on your Nook tablet (including the Nook HD and HD+).

**Note:** *Some digital formats may not be available from all libraries.*

## Step 1

- Download the OverDrive app from one of the following:

## Step 2

Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in. If you're under 13, select **I am under 13 years old** instead.

**Note:** *If you're using a NOOK Color or Tablet, skip this step and move on to step 3.*

## Step 3

In the OverDrive app, find the Kendallville Public Library's OverDrive website (eIndiana Digital Consortium). On most NOOK tablets, you can do this by swiping from left to right to open the **Home menu**, then tapping **Add a library**.

On a NOOK Color or Tablet, tap the  icon (or, if you don't have this icon, go to *Menu > Get Books*).

Tap the star to save your library to your library list.

Tap your library's name to start browsing.

## Step 4

Log in with your library card and borrow titles.

## Step 5

Borrowed titles can be found under your account on the OverDrive website. You can:

- Download EPUB eBooks\* and MP3 audiobooks directly to the OverDrive app.
- Add streaming videos to the OverDrive app.
- Tap **Read** to open and read OverDrive materials.
- Read eBooks right in your browser.
- Tap **Send to NOOK** to send a periodical to your library on your NOOK tablet.

If you've installed the Kindle reading app from the Google Play store on your NOOK, select **Kindle Book** (U.S. only) to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle reading app.

**Note:** *If you're using a NOOK Color or Tablet, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete.*

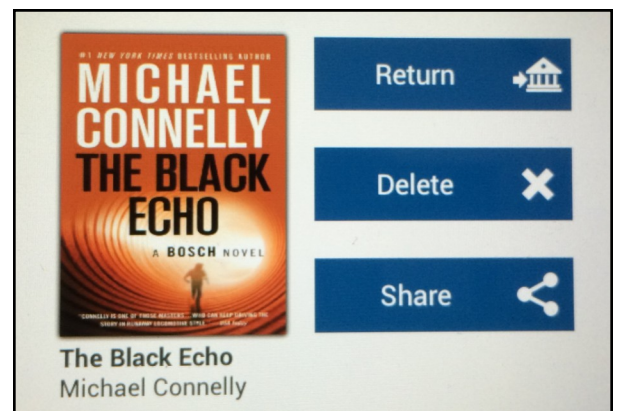
## How to return eBooks, audiobooks, or streaming videos

From your app bookshelf, tap and hold a title to display its return options.

*Note: If you're using the legacy version of OverDrive's app, tap the + next to a book, then tap **Return / Delete** to show return options.*

You can select **Return**, which will return the book to the library and also deletes the title from your device.

You can **Delete** a title from your device, but you will still have it checked out to your library account.
