Dear 4th, 5th or 6th Grade Teacher,



It's time for the **18th Annual Kleiman Creative Writing Contest**, presented by the Kendallville Public Library and open to all 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students.

Many of you have completed this contest a number of times, and are familiar with the rules. There are a few changes listed below for your convenience, and the complete rules are attached.

Things to look for or look forward to:

1. You **DO NOT** need to do a special piece just for this contest - have students pull a current work out of their writing folders to develop, edit, and revise.
2. You can create electronic books, but remind kids that neatness counts. They can also draw pictures and import them into a book created in Scribble Press to encourage this. However, they still must be printed out by the contestant or teacher and given to the library by the deadline.
3. **There will STILL be amazing prizes!**
4. Contest can be used as a class project (meeting a LARGE number of standards in one project!) by incorporating the writing, editing, and illustrating of the books into the curriculum.
5. Classes with 100% participation receive a special **PRIZE** for your classroom.
6. It's a chance for students to see a multi-step project through to the end.
7. Student's books will all be bound and returned with a participation certificate.
8. **Invite us to your room!** We would LOVE to help present a variety of literary formats, encourage reading and writing, display past winners, explain contest rules and more! We are even willing to visit multiple times to introduce genres unique traits.
9. Every participant and teacher is invited to an **awards banquet** in the spring.
10. TEACHERS can participate too!

2017 Kleiman Creative Writing Contest

Open to Students in the 4th, 5th and 6th Grades

Contest Rules:

- All books must be written and illustrated by the same student using stories and characters that are their original work created during this school year.
- The book must include a front cover, title page and back cover.
- There is **no minimum or maximum number of pages** (**Graphic Novels and Poetry must have a total of 10 pages including the covers and title page**), unless specified by the individual teacher
- The front cover must include an illustration, the title, and student's name.
- The title page must include an illustration, title, the student's name and the date.
- The back cover is a free choice, but cannot be left blank.
- Books should be made using 8 ½" by 11" sheets of paper. Text should be set within 1" margins.
- A page number is required at the bottom of each page, and can be part of the artwork. See attached illustration for page layout. Do not number the front cover, title page or back cover.
- There must be text on every two page spread (ask for samples if needed). Typed text needs to be at least 12 point font and written text needs to be clear and easy to read. Be creative with your text, play with size and color. Please do not color over text.
- There must be at least one illustration on every two page spread. **Art must be original, but can be created using a computer or iPad. Please do not use clipart or Google images as they are not allowed. Drawing art and importing it into a computer or iPad program is encouraged.**
- Please turn in a paper copy of your book. Put the book together in the correct order with the **required entry form** on top. Use a **paper clip** to hold the book together. ****If creating an electronic copy of the book, please have teachers/parents print a copy to turn in. Your teacher may print the entire classes books on provided paper and turn in to the library.**
- **The deadline for all entries is March 17, 2017.** They must be received by closing time (6:00 p.m.) and may be delivered to either the Kendallville Public Library or its Limberlost Branch in Rome City
- Entries may be picked up after the Awards Program, held in the spring. The cost for student meals, one guest, and teacher meals will be underwritten by the Kleiman family.
